# Four Progressive awards

#### **Scout Pathfinder Award**

For Scouts who are 11 or above and have attained the Membership Badge. Sea Scouts must choose 'Sea Acitivites' and Air Scouts must choose 'Air Activities' from the electives.



#### **Scout Advanced Award**

For Scouts who have completed the Scout Standard Award, or aged 13 or above who have attained the Membership badge and have completed the Outdoor Challenge section of the Pathfinder and Standard Awards. Sea Scouts must choose 'Sea Acitivites' whereas Air Scouts must choose 'Air Activities' from the electives. Other Scout must follow the same elective as for their Scout Pathfinder Award and Scout Standard Award.



#### **Scout Standard Award**

For Scouts who have completed the Pathfinder Award, or aged 13 or above who have attained the Membership badge and have completed the Outdoor Challenge section of the Pathfinder Award. Sea Scouts must choose 'Sea Activities' whereas Air Scouts must choose 'Air Activities' from the electives. Other Scout must follow the same elective as for their Scout Pathfinder Award.



#### **Chief Scout's Award**

Suitable for scouts who have completed the Scout Advanced Award, or aged 13 or above who completed the Outdoor Challenge sections in the Pathfinder, Standard and Advanced Award. Sea Scouts must choose 'Sea Activities' whereas Air Scouts must choose 'Air Activities' from the electives. Other scouts must follow the same elective as for their Scout Pathfinder Award.

- Interest: 25 badges
- Pursuit: 28 badges

# Badge requirement of outdoor challenge for the SSA and SAA

- Outdoor challenge
  - SSA
    - Attain a proficiency badge related to outdoor activities, such as Park Orienteering (Interest), Naturalist (Interest), Geologist (Interest), Footdrill (Interest) etc.
  - SAA
    - Attain two of the following proficiency badges: Camper (Pursuit), Explorer (Pursuit),
      Pioneering (Pursuit), Backwoods Cooking (Pursuit)

# Badge requirement for the CSA 1/2

### Personal development

- Attain a proficiency badge related to physical fitness that you have not attained in pervious Progressive Badges, e.g., Dragon Boatman (Interest), Houseman (Interest), Rowing Boatman (Interest), Athlete (Interest), Windsurfer (Interest), Archery (Pursuit), Skipper (Pursuit), Canoeist (Pursuit), Orienteer (Pursuit), Marksman (Pursuit), Masterat-arms (Pursuit), Sailor (Pursuit) or Skin Diver (Pursuit) etc.
- Attain the Leadership Award

#### Service

 Attain one of the following proficiency badge: First Aid (Service), Fireman (Service), Life-saver (Service)

# Badge requirement for the CSA 2/2

#### Environment

 Attain a proficiency badge related to environment which you have not attained in the previous Progressive Badges; such as Geologist (Interest), Naturalist (Interest), Smallholder (Interest), Conservator (Service) or Tree Carer (Interest) proficiency badge, World Conservation Badge or the World Scout Environment Badge.

#### New experience

Attain a Proficiency Badge (Instructor).
